

Fashion Reimagined

Fashion designer Amy Powney of cult label Mother of Pearl is a rising star in the London fashion scene. Raised off-the-grid in rural England by activist parents, Amy has always felt uneasy about the devastating environmental impact of her industry. When she wins the coveted Vogue award for the Best Young Designer of the Year, which comes with a big cash prize, Amy decides to use the money to create a sustainable collection from field to finished garment and transform her entire business. Over the following three years, her own personal revolution becomes the precursor of a much bigger, societal change.

Peter O'Toole: Along the Sky Road to Aqaba

Documentary about legendary actor Peter O'Toole who brought a touch of danger to his art and a stroke of madness to his life yet inspired a generation of movie makers.

Reflecting O'Toole's theatrical legacy, this film is structured into four acts each introduced by a quote about O'Toole that encapsulates his life during a specific period.

Each act expands into a holistic narrative addressing questions such as his self-belief, his alcoholism, his relationships with women, his belief in socialism and his selective embrace of Irishness.

While O'Toole's words (gleaned from hundreds of hours of archival interviews) act as a narrator of his own journey, Jim Sheridan further explores the story through interviews with O'Toole's family, artists, actors and directors that knew him well.

In Ross Kemp: Deep Sea Treasure Hunter our host travels further around the world to dive even deeper on shipwrecks of major historical importance. 


What's Love Got to Do with It?


