UEFA Euro 2004: Hungary v Switzerland Saturday, 1.15pm 15th June ITV1

Mark Pougatch presents as Hungary and Switzerland meet for the first time at a European Championship - kinging off their Group A campaigns in Cologne.

Liverpool midfielder Dominik Szoboszlai is the heartbeat of the Hungarian side and will be key to their chances, while Murat Yakin's Switzerland will be led by the evercombative Granit Xhaka. Commentary is by Clive Tyldesley and Andros Townsend.



UEFA Euro 2024: Spain v Croatia Saturday, 4.15pm 15th June ITV1

Mark Pougatch is joined by pundits Ian Wright, Roy Keane and Gary Neville as Euro giants Spain and Croatia begin their respective Group B campaigns in Berlin

The two teams meet again after their epic Round of 16 game at Euro 2020 that ended in a memorable 5-3 win for Spain in Copenhagen after extra time. Commentary on what should be a brilliant encounter comes from Seb Hutchinson and Lee Dixon.









UEFA Euro 2024: Slovenia v Denmark Sunday, 4.10pm 16th June ITV1

Laura Woods presents alongside Gary Neville, Joleon Lescott and Eni Aluko as Slovenia and Denmark - who are in England's group - face off in their opening match.

Slovenia haven't qualified for a European Championship since 2000, but their opponents Denmark reached the semi-finals of Euro 2020 where they lost to England. There's also all of the latest news from the England camp ahead of their opener against Serbia.



UEFA Euro 2024: Belgium v Slovakia Monday, 4.15pm 17th June ITV1

Mark Pougatch is joined by former England internationals Eni Aluko and Joleon Lescott - and Sheffield Wednesday boss Danny Rohl for this clash in Frankfurt.

Belgium's holden generation have failed to deliver on their promise at major tournaments to date, but have match-winners throughout their team. Slovakia qualified in second place behind Portugal, and will be out to cause an upset in this encounter.









UEFA Euro 2024: Austria v France Monday, 7.15pm 17th June ITV1

Laura Woods presents as Didier Deschamps' France - one of the favourites after reaching the 2022 World Cup final - begin their campaign against Austria.

All eyes will be on Real Madrid's newest signing Kylian Mbappé as France look to make an early mark on the tournament. Roy Keane, Gary Neville and Ian Wright provide the analysis, with commentary from the Duffeldorf Arena by Sam Matterface and Lee Dixon.



ITV Racing Live: Royal Ascot Tuesday & Friday, 1.30pm Wednesday & Thursday, 4.15pm 18th-21st June ITV1

Ed Chamberlin and Francesca Cumani present coverage of one of the biggest events on the horse racing calendar, with all of the week's races available on ITV and ITV4.

Tuesday's highlight is the St James's Palace Stakes for the classic generation, while Wednesday has the Prince of Wales's Stakes. On Thursday it's the Gold Cup that takes centre stage, while the Coronation Stakes and the Commonwealth Cup are on Friday.









Code Blue: One Punch Killers Tuesday, 9pm 18th June ITV1

A documentary looking at cases of one-punch attacks that explores their causes and speaks to family and friends of victims who were left devastated by them.

There have been a reported 82 one-punch killings over the past five years across the UK - with rare access to detectives in South Wales Police's Major Crimes Unit, this film looks at three one-punch cases and explores the role alcohol and violent culture has to play.



UEFA Euro 2024: Croatia v Albania Wednesday, 1pm 19th June ITV1

Mark Pougatch presents coverage alongside Ian Wright, Karen Carney and Danny Rohl as Croatia take on Sylvinho's Albania in their second match in UEFA Euro 2024.

Croatia have great international pedigree having reached the last four in the 2018 and 2022 World Cups, but Albania manager - Brazilian and former Arsenal defender Sylvinho - oversaw an impressive qualifying campaign where they finished top of the group.

In this special programme, Adam uncovers the realities of the British LGBTQ+ experience compared to his own in the United States. With conservatism on the rise and hate crime increasing, Adam asks how far we've come and how far we still have to go.



UEFA Euro 2024: Slovenia v Serbia Thursday, 1pm 20th June ITV1

Laura Woods presents as England's UEFA Euro 2024 Group C rivals Slovenia and Serbia meet in Munich - analysis is from Eni Aluko, Joleon Lescott and Danny Rohl.

English eyes will be on this encounter, with crucial points and group positions on the line. Neither of these two teams are fancied to go far in the tournament, but the new extended format means all group stage points are crucial - who will come out on top?









UEFA Euro 2024: Spain v Italy Thursday, 7.15pm 20th June ITV1

Mark Pougatch is joined by Ian Wright, Roy Keane and Gary Neville as two-time winners Spain face defending champions Italy in Group B in Gelsenkirchen.

Spain thrashed the Azzurri 4-0 in the final of Euro 2012 to lift their second successive title, but the Italians gained revenge in 2021 when they triumphed on penalties at Wembley in the semi-final. Commentary comes from Clive Tyldesley and Ally McCoist.



UEFA Euro 2024: Poland v Austria Friday, 4.15pm 21st June ITV1

Laura Woods presents alongside Joleon Lescott, Karen Carney and Danny Rohl in Berlin as Poland take on Austria in their second match at UEFA Euro 2024.

Poland qualified for the tournament through the play-offs at the expense of Wales while Austria had a strong qualifying campaign just finishing second to Belgium in the automatic positions. Seb Hutchinson and Andros Townsend provide the commentary.
